"not every article at the top of your search is reliable"

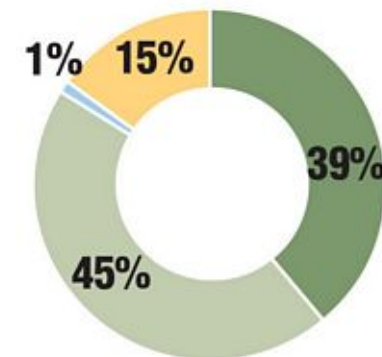

The percent of U.S. adults who are ___ in their ability to recognize made-up news

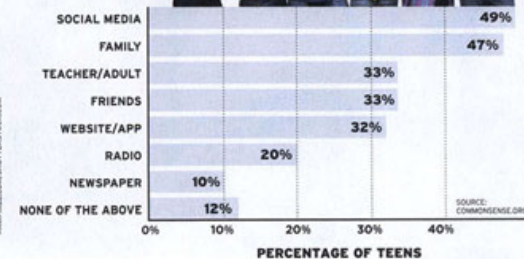
- Very confident


HOW TEENS GET THEIR NEWS

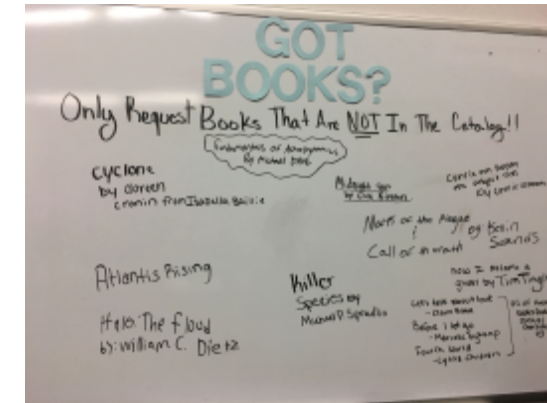
