2 out of 3 private sector jobs are created by small businesses

High growth startups account for 70% of net job creation

Startups create new wealth: High growth startups increase revenues by a minimum of 20% annually for four years or more, starting from a revenue base of at least \$1 million.

Related: Data from the Cooperative Institutional Research Program (CIRP) at the Higher Education Research Institute at UCLA, surveys reveal, Millennials are less interested in becoming successful entrepreneurs than baby boomers were when they were the same age. The share of college freshmen that said "becoming successful in a business of my own" was "essential" or "very important" to them dropped from 47.9 percent in 1977 to 41.2 percent in 2012.

THE COOL FACTOR: Diverse Career Opportunities For Recruiting & Retaining Talent Millennials seek purpose in the workplace: Startups provide this platform as their employees build the company brick-by-brick

Long view: 9 out of 10 employees in a startup wish to leave their jobs to move on to bigger corporates

> According to Deloitte's 2014 Millennial Survey, Milliennials Desire <u>Three I's in their career:</u> <u>Independence, innovation and</u> <u>impact.</u> While larger, established employers have struggled to provide these three "I's," startups require employees to work independently, create innovative solutions and produce an immediate impact.

Startups are the most appropriate metric for determining economic growth

> Startups differentiate themselves from other companies by expanding not just in size but also in number of new locations, creating economic ties to other geographic areas.


