 Broad access to news and instantaneous access to online information can be confusing, misleading and wrong.








 Luckily, schools nationwide are using nonfiction produced by reputable writers and publishers to teach not only the subject matter but also reading.



- History (for students with good research skills)




Chapter 2—Got Otter?


