The historic town of **Carlisle** is noted for its restored architecture and tree-lined streets. Find unique shopping, a diverse collection of dining, historic landmarks, car shows, military history, museums and more.

Notable Event: Harvest of the Arts (September): Juried arts shows with family events and activities.

Experience the diverse collection of towns that make up the West Shore including **Lemoyne**, **Wormleysburg**, **Enola** and **Camp Hill**. Enjoy a meal on the finest riverfront dining, relax at one of the many day spas or shop 'til you drop at the 60,000 sq. ft. West Shore Farmers Market.

Notable Events: Pennsboro Pumpkin Festival (October): Craft Festival featuring vendors, food and live entertainment.

Plein Air Arts Competition & Arts Festival (May): Outdoor arts competition, demonstrations and more in Camp Hill.

Mechanicsburg is an eco-conscious town that offers a beautiful landscape marked with museums, beautiful art galleries, a charming bed and breakfast and one-of-a-kind shops like Civil War & More.

Notable Event: Jubilee Day (June): The largest, longest-running, one-day street fair on the East Coast.





THE COLLECTOR IN YOU



Spark your inner treasure hunter and spend an afternoon, a day or an entire weekend browsing through the collection of artisan shops and antique stores of Cumberland Valley.



Begin the search for the ultimate collectible at the **Antique Marketplace of Lemoyne**. This ivy-lined brick building features a huge floor of distinct antique sections. Each corner is labeled with its seller and everything is easy to see and price tags are quick to find.

While on the West Shore, continue antiques at **Rose Marie's Antiques** in Camp Hill and **Veronique's Antiques** in Mechanicsburg.

Browsers with time to spare will appreciate **Northgate Antiques** in Carlisle. They have over 70 dealers and tons of floor space to cover. Not a corner of Northgate Antiques is wasted and an entire afternoon can be spent perusing through stoneware, clothing, jewelry and books.

Another Carlisle must-stop is **Bedford Street Antiques**. This uniquely shaped brick building, which has been a church, garment company and auction house, is filled with antiques and collectibles. They currently boast over 100 dealers and 24,000 sq. ft. to explore.

Other antiques opportunities in Carlisle include **Firehouse Antiques** and **Antiques on Hanover**, which specializes in furniture.

Take a break from antiques to seek out the modern creations that can be found in the Valley, including beautiful artwork and hand-crafted gifts.

One of the best places to start is the **Village Artisans Gallery** in Boiling Springs. This beautiful shop is filled with fine art and

crafts from PA and the U.S. Traditional and contemporary crafts such as blown glass, pottery, turned wood, wrought iron, hand woven apparel and jewelry can be found.

Before leaving Boiling Springs, stop by the **Gerald W. Putt Studio**. This award-winning painter specializes in nature and wildlife artwork.

Experience more fine art at **Nancy Stamm's Galleria** and **The Garden Gallery**, both located in downtown Carlisle. Hand-crafted jewelry and one-of-a-kind pottery can also be found at **Colucci & Company** in Carlisle, where the owner is usually creating jewelry as customers walk in the door.

The West Shore does not skimp on arts either. The **Art & Soul Gallery**, located inside the **West Shore Farmers Market** in Lemoyne, features a diverse selection of fine art and paintings that focus on local scenery.

Before leaving the West Shore area, visit **Tickle My Senses Gallery** in New Cumberland. This downtown gallery specializes in North American contemporary arts and crafts. Also, don't miss the **2nd Floor Gallery** in Mechanicsburg. This two-story gallery featuring over 500 works of art is a true experience.

Extend the search for unique finds from one day to an entire weekend. Pick up a **Rt. 15 ByWay of the Arts** brochure and trail map at the Cumberland Valley Visitors Center. This ultimate art-filled getaway will take you on a Rt. 15 journey through Cumberland Valley. Highlights include Hunters Valley Winery, the PCCA Gallery, the Village Artisans Gallery, and more.

Portable toilet available in large gravel lot. Follow the AT blazes across Bucher Hill Road, along the famous fly-fishing stream Yellow Breeches Creek, then along Children's Lake. Continue past the gazebo to the ATC. You can also head south on the AT, crossing a beautiful historic stone bridge, zig zagging through farm fields & taking a steady climb up South Mountain to Center Point Knob, the original midway point of the trail. The large holes you pass are from iron ore mining for the foundry located in the parking lot.

4 Ironmaster's Mansion



For an alternative hike, turn right & follow the trail along Conodoguinet Creek.



From easy to extreme, there are over 200 miles of trails in Cumberland Valley that can satisfy any hiker. To find more trails, go to visitcumberlandvalley.com/things-to-do/outdoor and use the search feature to find trail lengths, scenic vistas and more.

EASY HIKE

Begin your leisurely hiking journey in Cumberland Valley along the Army Heritage Trail at the U.S. Army Heritage & Education Center.

This mile-long loop trail is the perfect warm up or wind down for any day outdoors.

While on the trail, experience an interpretive timeline of U.S. history. Large, military exhibits include a Huey helicopter, tank, Civil War cabins and WWI trenches.

Easy hiking and biking can be found on the western side of the valley at the Cumberland Valley Rail Trail. This 11-mile trail follows the abandoned railroad tracks from Shippensburg to Newville. The majority of the trail is a two-tread trail with grassy, hard-packed earth perfect for equestrians and packed stone dust for hikers and bikers. The trail also features interpretive signage detailing the agricultural and historic significance of the trail and surrounding lands.

Find more relaxing hiking opportunities at the Cumberland County Hiker-Biker Trail located in the Pine Grove Furnace State Park. Entrances to the trail can be found at the beautiful Laurel and Fuller lakes and the 4-mile out and back trail is ideal for easy hiking and biking.

Discover the scenic and laid-back hiking that LeTort Spring Run and Nature Trail has to offer in Carlisle. This 2 mile, grass covered ballast trail follows one of the finest limestone trout streams in the country, LeTort Spring Run.

MODERATE/DIFFICULT HIKE

To get your adrenaline pumping and for a real challenge, take on one of the more difficult hiking trails in Cumberland Valley.

Sunset Rocks Trail's rewarding 8.3 miles includes short climbs but leads to beautiful views and ruins of a top-secret World War II POW camp. This trail takes you through the Michaux State Forest for opportunities to see an assortment of plant, tree and wildlife species. NOTE: There is a short section of two-handed climbing over boulders. Download the self-guided WWII POW Camp walking tour on visitcumberlandvalley.com.

Flat Rock Trail, located in Colonel Denning State Park, is a difficult hike with a very worthwhile ending. This 5-mile, strenuous hike, ends with a half-mile of climbing over rocks to a stunning vista of Cumberland Valley. Make sure you wear good, sturdy shoes, bring a trail snack and lots of water.

The short, but steep, hike up to Pole Steeple results in an excellent viewpoint for the central part of the South Mountain Massif. From the top you can see the Sunset Rocks on Little Rocky Ridge and, nearly 500 feet below, Laurel Lake with its beaches and dams.

OUTDOORS

Found it. Camping, bird watching, kayaking, hiking, swimming and breathtaking views of the lush Valley. Explore over 54,000 acres including three state parks, two state forests and over 200 miles of trails and over 100 local parks.

1760s

Pontiac's Rebellion: Colonel Henry Bouquet leads a group of Carlisle men to assist in raids against Native Americans.

1775-1783

American Revolutionary War: Cumberland Valley contributes supplies, food, weapons and soldiers to the fight for independence. **Carlisle Barracks**, the second-oldest Army post in the U.S., becomes a supply headquarters (see page 29 for listing).

August 2, 1776

Cumberland County attorneys — George Ross, James Smith and James Wilson — sign the Declaration of Independence at the **First Presbyterian Church** (see page 29 for listing).

June 28, 1778

Molly Ludwig Hays McCauley joins the war effort with her husband, William Hays, and earns the nickname "**Molly Pitcher**" by running pitchers of water to members of the Continental Army during the Battle of Monmouth.

1791-1794

Whiskey Rebellion: October 1794 - General George Washington and 14,000 militiamen meet at the Carlisle Barracks on their way to suppress the Whiskey Rebellion.

Civil War: Confederate forces move through the Valley on their way to Harrisburg, fighting against the Union in Carlisle, Shippensburg and Mechanicsburg. One of the columns at the **Old Courthouse** in Carlisle bears marks caused by Confederate artillery fire.

Civil War: Free African-American and soldiers quickly erect **Fort Couch** in Lemoyne to help defend Harrisburg from a Confederate invasion into Pennsylvania.

1914-1918

World War I: The Defense Distribution Center, built in New Cumberland, is recognized at the time as the largest facility of its kind operated by the U.S. Department of Defense. It is currently used for consolidated management and logistics.

1939-1945

World War II: The Naval Support Station in Mechanicsburg is established, June 17, 1943, as an inland supply depot for the U.S. Navy, and remains an important Navy and defense supply facility.



History Facts

It's important to know where you are going and where you have been. That's why we invite you to discover a few hidden history facts about Cumberland Valley. These may inspire a trip to uncover more pieces of the past.

The General Jenkins Monument in Mechanicsburg is the farthest north Confederate monument in the U.S. Jenkins was a plantation slave-owner and former Congressman from Virginia. The monument was designed by noted Civil War artist Gary Casteel.

A train ran down the entire length of High Street in Carlisle for 99 years. It made its last run in 1937. You can read about it on the Wayside Marker on the NW corner of W. High Street.

Pennsylvania's only U.S. President, James Buchanan is one of the famous alumni from Dickinson College, founded in 1773.

The legendary Molly Pitcher is renowned for her bravery at the Battle of Monmouth during the Revolutionary War where she allegedly assisted her husband at his gun station. Visit her grave and statue at the Old Graveyard in Carlisle on E. South Street.

Olympian Jim Thorpe, along with 10,000 other American Indian children, attended the controversial Carlisle Indian School from 1879 to 1918, now the grounds of the Carlisle Barracks.

George Washington really did sleep here – for an entire week in October 1794. So did 14,000 militia men. They came to Carlisle to march with Washington to Western PA to quell the Whiskey Rebellion.

The Carlisle Barracks maintains more than 100 historic buildings, 22 of which are listed in the National Historic Register.

Organized in 1789, the Union Fire Co. 1 in Carlisle is the longest, continuously operating fire company in the U.S. and is also home to a unique museum.



Among those buried at the Locust Grove Cemetery in Shippensburg are twenty-six black Civil War veterans who served with the U.S. Colored Troops between 1863 and 1865. Those veterans include men who served with the 54th and 55th Massachusetts Volunteer Regiments, the first combat units open to African-American men during the Civil War, which were the units featured in the movie Glory.

The Naval Support Station in Mechanicsburg was established as one of the several inland supply depots for the U.S. Navy during World War II. Although its mission has evolved, the base remains an important Navy and defense supply facility.



The Old Courthouse in Carlisle is the best preserved, operating courthouse in the country. One of the columns bears the mark of the artillery barrage that followed before General Robert E. Lee ordered the Confederate cavalry unit to the Battle of Gettysburg.
