## Baere Brewing Co.

320 BROADWAY ST., UNIT E

Baere Brewing has a strong following of locals from Denver's Baker neighborhood. The bar is made from reclaimed boxcar floors and the aesthetic is warm and comforting.

## Beryl's Beer Co.

At Black Sky heavy metal constantly pours through the speakers while 23 taps pour Black Sky brews as well as Colorado guest beers. New Haven-style pizza is served daily, and the outdoor patio is the perfect lunch spot.

## Breckenridge Brewery

Enjoy stunning mountain views from The Farm House at Breckenridge Brewery. The beer garden is complete with picnic tables, lush landscapes, covered seating and a "Colorado fresh" menu.

## Denver ChopHouse & Brewery

## Crooked Stave

## Denver Beer Co.

## Epic Brewing

3001 WALNUT ST.

In 2013, Epic expanded its operations with a second brewery in the River North (RiNo) district. The spacious tap room has 25 taps offering seasonals and special "one off" firkins.

## Factotum Brewhouse

3845 LIPAN ST.

Amateur brewers are the root of Denver's craft beer success, and Factotum Brewhouse provides home-brewers a stage to display their craft, refine recipes and receive unbiased public feedback. Rotating beers are the norm at Factotum, so every trip is a new experience.

## Fiction Beer Company

7101 E COLFAX AVE.

Fiction Beer Company crafts liquid literature through recipes inspired by the brewer's favorite works of fiction. Grab a seat at the bar made out of books, ponder literary quotes written on the tables or relax on the patio with a Pale Ale inspired by Jack Kerouac's *On the Road*.

## Great Divide Brewing Co

Great Divide's flavorful beers represent a lifestyle that is uniquely Coloradan. The tap room has outdoor seating filled with locals and tourists alike, and Denver's best food trucks stay parked street-side should you want a snack with your Yeti.

## Jagged Mountain Craft Brewery

1139 20TH ST.

Adventurous people making adventurous beer. Jagged Mountain maintains this theme by exploring new styles and ingredients, rejecting standard styles and regularly offering varied selections of craft beer. With some select crafts topping out at an impressive 14.5% ABV, an adventurous spirit is needed.

## Lost Highway Brewing Company

520 E COLFAX AVE.

The first brewery located on Denver's historic Colfax Ave., Lost Highway specializes in Belgian-style ales. The beers reflect the history of Colfax and the Capitol Hill neighborhood with names like Longest, Wickedest Wit and O.G. Colfax Porter.

## Prost Brewing

2540 19TH ST.

Prost combines the best parts of a Bavarian-style biergarten outside, with a traditional bier hall layout inside, giving you the feel of an afternoon or evening spent in Munich. The signature copper brewing equipment was shipped from Germany and the commitment to brewing authentic German-style bier holds true in their Colorado brews.

## Ratio Beerworks

Grab your friends and enjoy some backyard drinking on a dog-friendly patio complete with yard games! Ratio is so dedicated to high quality beer that the whole batch is dumped out if it isn't perfect.

## Renegade Brewing Company

925 W 9TH AVE.

Renegade's taproom is filled with the rumble of conversation accented with laughter coming from friends and families. The laid-back tasting room is where the Art District on Santa Fe community comes together.

## Rock Bottom Restaurant & Brewery

## Spangalang Brewery
