In the summer of 2014, 50 new sculptural bike racks were installed throughout Fort Wayne!

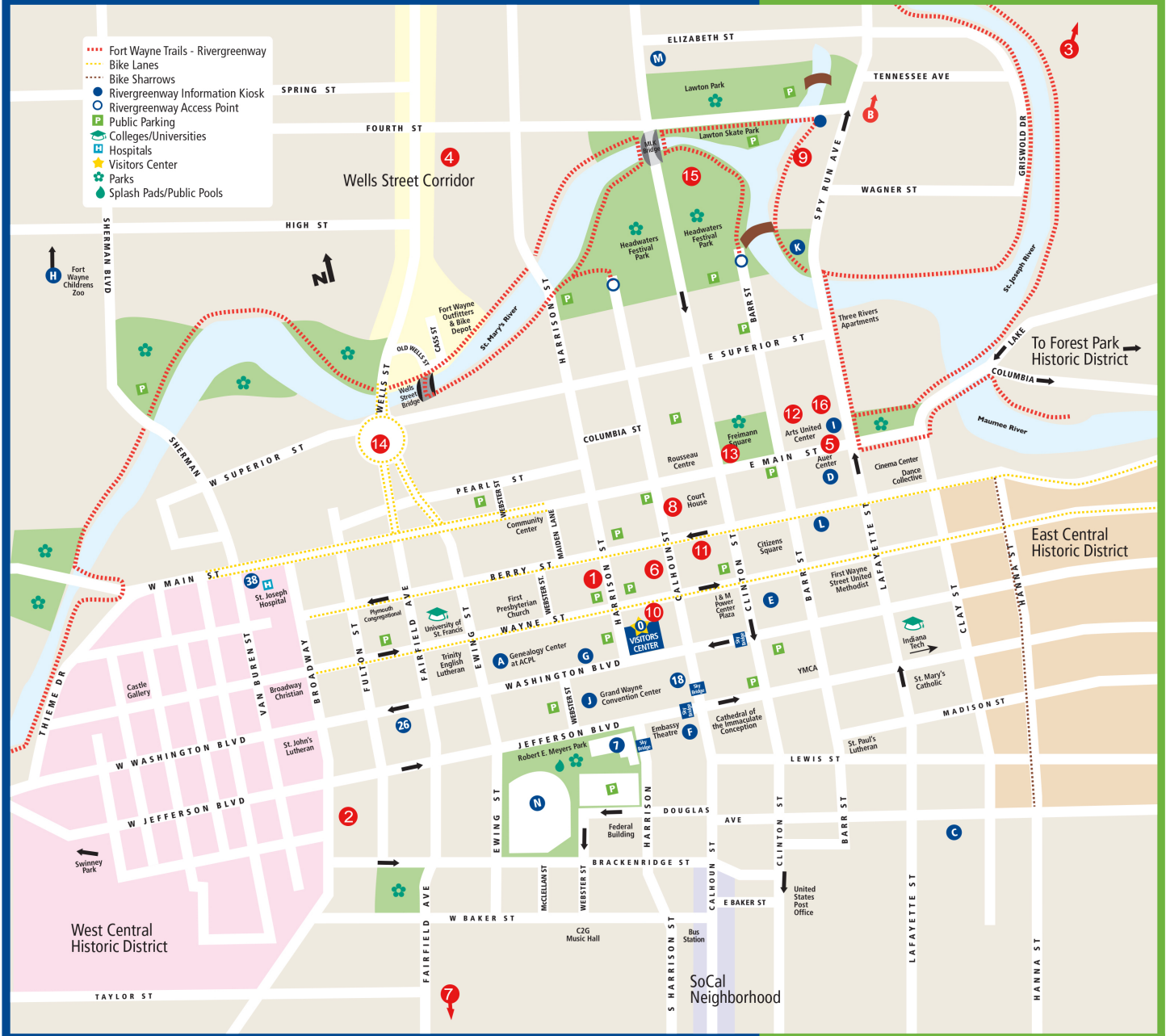

DOWNTOWN MAP

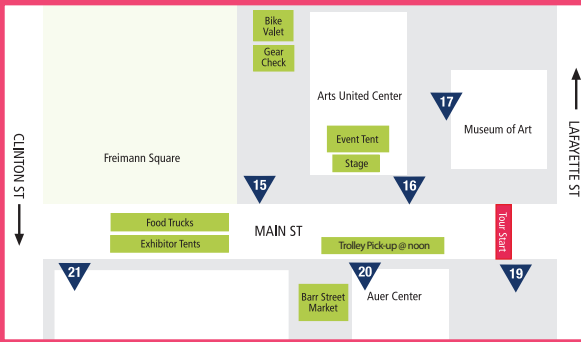

KICKSTART MAP



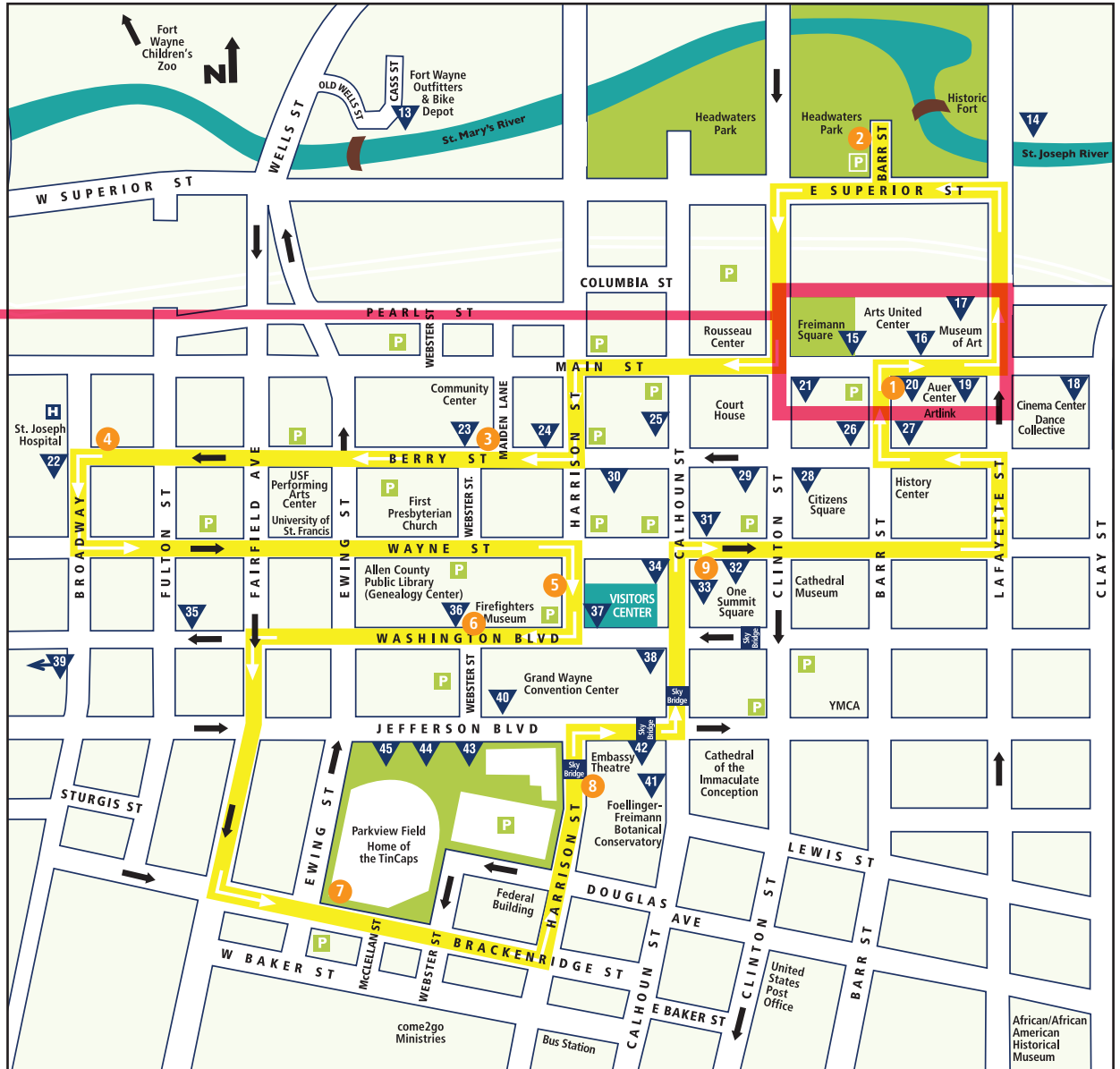

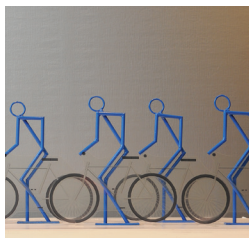
Yellow line = Trolley Route Orange circle = Trolley Stop Locations
