Inspired on a bike ride through Fort Worth's streets, the brewery's name is about a fusion of art, bicycles, friends and great craft beer. Founders Macy Moore and Matt Hill, who are co-owners with Chuck Epperson, say their passions run deep and far - the outdoors, cycling, the arts, metal work, local food, good friends, friendly dogs and, yes, fine craft brew. They discovered along the way that craft beer isn't about a product or even a brand. It's about community and friends. "At its core, craft beer is about the experience."

IF YOU ONLY TRY ONE

One of the popular pours is the Feisty Blonde, a wild spin on the traditional blonde ale, combining deeply aromatic orange blossom honey with a touch of pure Mexican vanilla and raw brown sugar for a rounded, smooth finish.

Rabbit Hole Brewing sold its first keg in late 2013 to the Mule Barn in Justin, a half-hour north of Fort Worth, but the creators worked long before that on their quality craft beer ideas. Homebrewers first, the trio of founders, Tom Anderson, Matt Morris and Laron Cheek are the Horsemen of the Hopocalypse.

IF YOU ONLY TRY ONE

Mike Modano's 561 Kolsch-style beer is a clean, crisp, yet deceptively complex brew which features a delicate balance between soft malt and a subtle fruity hoppiness. Crafted to commemorate Mike's record career goals for U.S.-born hockey players, 561 showcases German pilsner malt, noble hops and a meticulous fermentation regimen.

BREW BUZZ

Founded in 2004 by Fritz and Erin Rahr, the brewery has roots to the 1800s, when Fritz's great-great grandfather immigrated to Wisconsin and started the first lager brewery in the U.S. Fritz likes to say he was born with beer in his blood. Rahr & Sons was first to open in DFW and remains among the most popular with at least 1,000 visitors each week and a production of more than 20,000 barrels annually.

IF YOU ONLY TRY ONE

Texas Red American Amber – Texas Red doesn't have any funny anecdotes about how it got its name and it wasn't the first beer we ever brewed, but this American Amber doesn't need any of that because the real story is its balanced flavor. The notes of caramel and its sound malt character are perfectly balanced with just a bit of hops.

About 35 miles southwest of Fort Worth, this countryside favorite was founded by the father-son team of Ron and Rhett Keisler and master brewer Grant Wood. Using fresh water from their Trinity Aquifer well, the team brews top-rate beer. Spending time here on Saturday is a weekly party with corn-bag toss games, horseshoes and Giant lenga.

IF YOU ONLY TRY ONE

Don't miss Blood and Honey, an unfiltered deep golden ale made with malted two row barley and wheat. The brew is finished with Blood Orange zest, local Fall Creek Farms Honey and other spices that bring special flavors to this unique beer.

Founded in Keller (a few minutes north of Fort Worth) in 2014 by Shannon Carter, who began brewing at home 25 years ago, thanks to a passion for beers from the U.K. and Ireland. Following an old-school process, Shannon brews with fire throughout the process, caramelizing sugar to give a certain flavor and using pure spring water from the ancient springs over which the brewery sits.

IF YOU ONLY TRY ONE

The Fire-Brewed Chocolate Stout is a stand out. Fire brewing gives this Shannon Brewery staple a flavor profile that is unique: malt-forward but very balanced and drinkable.

OFF THE TRAIL

Take this detour to see the other side of Fort Worth's fermented libations. You may need to stay an extra day...

Acre Distillery & Coffee

Acre Distilling and Coffee Co. is a craft distillery offering small batch offerings of bourbon, gin, whiskey and vodka. Housed in the heart of Fort Worth's infamous Hell's Half Acre in downtown, hence its name, the distillery offers breakfast bites and local coffee options in the morning and tasty libations by night.
