shipwreck park

The dramatic sinking of Lady Luck, a 324-foot ship, took place in July, just a mile from the Pompano Beach fishing pier. Lady Luck is now the centerpiece of the new **Shipwreck Park** for divers, complete with underwater art exhibits. She is one of the largest contributions to Florida's artificial reef system and is the most easily accessible major dive site in the nation with at least 16 other shipwrecks in the vicinity. port everglades cruise update

Port Everglades welcomes two newly built cruise ships, Holland America's ms Koningsdam and Royal Caribbean's Harmony of the Seas, in November 2016. A fourth cruise ship will be added to the summer 2017 roster with Carnival Cruise's Carnival Splendor, and luxury cruise line Crystal Cruises will begin sailing from Port Everglades in October 2017.

News: Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport opened Concourse G in Terminal 4 with new concession areas and five new gates and is part of the first phase of a \$450 million expansion and modernization project. Phase Two will include an interactive walkway and nine new gates. When completed in mid-2018, the terminal will have 12 international and 2 domestic gates. The addition of Concourse A in Terminal 1 is underway and will include a Customs Inspection Facility with five gates handling both international and domestic flights and is expected to be completed May 2017.

New international service includes: Norwegian Air Shuttle: Paris (Aug 2016) and Guadeloupe, West Indies (Dec 2016); Southwest: Nassau (Aug 2016); JetBlue: Santa Clara, Cuba (Mon, Wed, Fri; Daily: Oct 2016); Camaguey, Cuba (Nov 2016), Holguin, Cuba (Nov 2016) and Havana, Cuba (Fall 2016). New domestic service includes: JetBlue: New Orleans (Sept 2016); Allegiant: Ogdensburg, NY (Oct 2016) and Niagara Falls (Nov 2016); Frontier: Cincinnati (Oct 2016 seasonal); Spirit: Newark (Oct 2016); Akron-Canton (Nov 2016); Southwest: Newark (May 2017); and United: Washington Dulles (Dec 2016 seasonal).

new on the hotel scene

The Conrad Fort Lauderdale Beach Resort is expected to open in winter 2017 with 290 expansive studio and suite accommodations, four alfresco dining experiences, a 4,000 sq ft ocean view spa and fitness center, elevated deck oasis with an ocean-facing pool and plush cabanas, and 20,000 sq ft of flexible meeting and event space.



HYDE Resort, the beachfront sister property to the newly opened Beachwalk Resort in Hallandale Beach, opens in 2017 with 300+ units, a pool, spa, and restaurant.

The Le Meridien Dania Beach at Fort Lauderdale Airport, formerly Sheraton Fort Lauderdale Airport & Cruise Port Hotel, is undergoing a \$30 million renovation and conversion and will feature 245 contemporary guest rooms, 20,000 sq ft of state-of-the-art flexible meeting space and two redesigned restaurants. Anticipated to open fall 2017.

A new \$21 million, 142 room Wyndham Garden Hotel in Dania Beach is expected to open late 2017 and plans to offer casual dining, flexible meeting space and an inviting lobby and lounge.

The historic Escape Hotel is being renovated and transformed into the Gale Boutique Hotel, with 96 rooms and 129 condo residences in Fort Lauderdale's North Beach Village. Estimated to open in late 2017.

A new 23-story Four Seasons will open in 2018 with 150 hotel rooms and 95 residences, two restaurants, a spa, fitness center, children's recreation room, "Beach Butlers" and ballroom and meeting facilities.

In downtown Fort Lauderdale, a dual-branded hotel complex, featuring the Tribute Portfolio Hotel: The Dalmar (209 rooms) will offer a rooftop lounge and sky lobby, an infinity pool and 24,000 sq ft of meeting and retail space. The Element Fort Lauderdale Downtown (114 rooms) will also be part of the hotel complex. Opens Mar 2018.

In addition to 136 loft-like rooms at Aloft Weston, the new property will offer 600 sq ft of meeting space and all the brand essentials such as WXYZ® bar, and a Splash pool. Opens Apr 2018. Aloft Fort Lauderdale will also provide loft-like rooms and all the brand's signature amenities, along with 1,500 sq ft of meeting facilities. Opens Jan 2019.

hotel refresh

The Diplomat Resort & Spa in Hollywood is undergoing a \$95 million transformation including guest rooms, lobby and restaurants & lounges. Completion fall 2016.

The W Fort Lauderdale is undergoing a \$55 million renovation restyle bringing a high-contrast, sleek design to 430 guestrooms & suites, Living Room (Lobby), WET Decks (2 Pools) and all the public spaces. The new guestrooms and suites will be complete by Nov 2016, followed by all public spaces by mid-Dec 2016. A new 4,000 sq ft ballroom is underway along with an additional 3-meals-a-day Stephen Starr restaurant with completion slated for early 2017.

The B Ocean Resort Fort Lauderdale has undergone an extensive renovation including a new front desk, meeting space, guestrooms, and the famous Wreck Bar. Plans are underway to enhance the overall food and beverage concepts throughout the hotel as well as entertainment options. Completion fall 2016.



The Renaissance Fort Lauderdale Cruise Port is completing a total brand transformation with renovations to the hotel lobby, restaurants, and meeting space (guestrooms were refurbished in 2015).

The Westin Fort Lauderdale Beach Resort is undergoing a \$5.5 million renovation including the transformation of the Porte cochere and lobby for a more inviting guest arrival experience, and a new oceanfront dining concept.

The Fort Lauderdale Marriott Harbor Beach Resort & Spa is renovating guestrooms with completion in mid-Nov 2016.

The Comfort Suites Airport & Cruise Port has been renamed Fort Lauderdale Airport/Cruise Port Inn as it transitions to Four Points by Sheraton 17th Street in Dec 2016.
