Start by parking near the Historic Noblesville Square. Offering cafes, restaurants, ice cream, shops, antiques and host to many special events.

BRIDGE OVER WHITE RIVER

Pass by the Nickel Plate Railroad tracks and cross the White River on the boardwalk bridge.
