#### **Directions**

**FROM POINTS SOUTH** (New York City, Mystic, CT) I-95 North to RI Exit 3A (Route 138 East). Follow signs for the Newport Bridge. Take first exit off the Newport Bridge (Scenic Newport). Turn right at the end of exit ramp. Go straight through first light. Turn right at second light onto America's Cup Avenue. Turn right onto Goat Island Connector Road for bus parking at the Newport Visitor Information & Transportation Center, 23 America's Cup Avenue.

## **FROM POINTS NORTH** (Boston Area)

Route 93 South to Route 128 South to Route 24 South to Route 195 West to Route 24 South (Exit 8B) to Route 138 South. Follow directions \*From Route 138 South (East Main Road), shown below.

## FROM CAPE COD

Foute 195 West to Route 24 South (Exit 8B) to Route 183 South. Follow directions \*From Route 138 South (East Main Road), shown below.

#### FROM PROVIDENCE

Route 195 East to Route 24 South to Route 138 South. Follow directions \*From Route 138 South (East Main Road), shown below.

#### \*From Route 138 South (East Main Road)

After 8 miles, turn left (Dunkin' Donuts is on your right) onto Route 138A (Aquidneck Avenue). At second light, turn left keeping on Aquidneck Ave. At next light keep right onto Memorial Boulevard, past beach and continue up the hill. Memorial Boulevard ends at Thames Street, then changes to America's Cup Avenue. Turn left onto Goat Island Connector Road for bus parking at the Newport Visitor Information & Transportation Center, 23 America's Cup Avenue.

## **USEFUL MOTORCOACH INFORMATION**

### **Traffic Flow**

Please be informed that touring vehicles may not stop or stand for description of points of interest. They must remain with the regular flow of traffic. Slow-moving vehicles are encouraged to pull to the side, when possible, to allow faster traffic to pass. Buses stopping in the lane of travel will be subject to ticketing by police.

# **Newport Regulations**

## **STANDING BUSES - IDLING ORDINANCE**

Standing buses shall not idle their engines for more than five minutes at any given time throughout the city. (Ord. 2001-10 § 1, 2001: Ord. 12094 § 1, 1994: prior code § 850.10)

#### **SPECIAL PARKING LIMITS**

During certain hours on certain streets (as marked) there is fifteen (15) minute parking for tour buses only, from 9:00am to 6:00pm.

#### **RESPONSIBILITY OF BUS DRIVERS**


The locations designated and marked out pursuant to Section 10.64.030 shall be and are established as bus stops in the city, and all public bus drivers shall stop their buses and receive or discharge passengers only at designated bus stops. (Prior code § 488.05)
