will service markets in Summit County and Salt Lake City during peak commute

Summit County stops will include the Old Town Transit Center, Kimball Junction businesses and Jeremy Ranch. Salt Lake City stops will include Salt Lake Central Station and the University of Utah. To view route times and additional information, please log onto www.rideuta.com.

BUSES Vehicles for the route are UTA express

coaches. These coaches are built for longer routes and are equipped with bike racks and WiFi where available.

PAYING YOUR FARE Fare payment methods include cash,

contactless tap debit/credit cards and

UTA electronic fare cards provided by participating employers or purchased online at www.rideuta.com. The cost to ride is \$4.50 for a one-way trip. 30-day passes are also available for \$162. ECO and ED passes are not accepted.

TRANSFERS

The **PC-SLC Connect** is a special service. Free transfers can be made to and from local UTA buses, TRAX and Park City Transit buses. The driver can provide you with a transfer pass.

- Locate your trip destination on the map. The blue area to the lower left shows the PC-SLC Connect service to Salt Lake City. The rest of the map shows our routes and destinations in Park City and Summit County.
- Not every destination is listed here, but you should be able to locate one nearby. Routes servicing select destinations are indicated by color.

BUS STOPS For passenger safety, drivers are instructed to pick-up and drop-off passengers at designated bus stops. Bus stops are easy to find. Just look for

the blue signs with white

lettering. Routes and departure times will be posted at each stop. Locations of all bus stops and transfer points are indicated on the route maps.

The Map is also on our website. Please plan to arrive at the bus stop a few minutes before the scheduled departure time. As the bus approaches, please check the destination display on the front of the bus to ensure you are boarding the correct bus.

WHILE ON THE BUS

We welcome you aboard our free bus system. Traffic and parking around town can be challenging, so ride the bus and relax. Our drivers can be a good source of information, so feel free to ask questions. Seats near the front of the bus should be offered to the elderly and riders with disabilities. For the safety and comfort of all passengers, please refrain from playing music without earphones. Smoking, eating, drinking and animals (with the exception of service animals) are prohibited.

An Express Bus travels directly between Park City's Old Town Transit Center (OTTC)

HWY 224 EXPRESS SERVICE

and Kimball Junction (in 15 minutes), departing the OTTC hourly. The first Express bus departs to Kimball Junction at 8:00 am; the last Express bus departs at 9:00 pm.


The Express bus also departs Kimball Junction at Newpark for Park City's Historic Main Street (:45) minutes after the hour, from 8:45 am until 9:45 pm.
